PANEL DISCUSSION: Where is global Justice? – Perspectives from Afghanistan, Iraq, Syria, Yemen and Libya

These countries have witnessed war, with international interventions aiming at bringing peace, but never succeeding. In fact, they often worsened the situation: bringing death to many, causing the destruction of infrastructure and violations of Human Rights, and forcing millions of people to leave their countries for safety. The panel discussion will debate the interests and responsibilities of these external forces: What does modern occupation and post-colonialism mean in this context? What is the role of weapon exports and exploitation of resources? How can those countries unite, liberate from external interests and achieve freedom, justice and peace again? And what is the role of critical Journalists in that? Finally, the question ‘Where is social justice?’ also invites the panelists to report from pockets of hope for justice and peace.
